Ferry Announces Weekend Service

The Water Emergency Transportation Authority (WETA) announced today that the Alameda/Oakland Ferry will launch its summer weekend schedule on Saturday, May 14. The summer weekend schedule features nine daily round trips between Oakland, Alameda, the San Francisco Ferry Building, and San Francisco's Pier 41/Fisherman's Wharf. In addition, there is weekend and holiday service to Angel Island State Park and to AT&T Park for weekday evening and weekend day Giants games.

The Alameda Main Street Ferry Terminal is located at 2990 Main Street. Free parking is available adjacent to the dock. The Oakland Jack London Square terminal is located near the intersection of Clay Street and the Embarcadero. Onboard amenities include a full-service beverage and snack bar. Bicycles are welcome. WETA operates the Alameda/Oakland and Alameda Harbor Bay ferry services. WETA was established in 2008 to develop a more robust ferry system and to increase the Bay Area's emergency response capabilities. WETA expects to operate Vallejo's Baylink ferry services later this year, and to begin new service from the East Bay to South San Francisco next year.
