Ferry Expands Service for Fleet Week Weekend

San Francisco Bay Ferry announced today that it will expand Alameda/Oakland ferry operations for Fleet Week weekend, October 8 and 9. The annual Fleet Week celebration, which features weekend air shows and the popular Parade of Ships, is expected to draw thousands of spectators to the San Francisco waterfront. To accommodate anticipated demand and provide the best views on the Bay, the ferry will run 18 roundtrips per day, compared to the usual nine. The expanded schedule offers hourly East Bay departures beginning at 9:00 a.m. and concluding with a 10:30 p.m. departure to San Francisco. In addition, there is service to Angel Island State Park on both Saturday and Sunday.

The Alameda/Oakland Ferry operates year round between Alameda Main Street, Oakland's Jack London Square, the San Francisco Ferry Building, San Francisco's Pier 39/Fisherman's Wharf with seasonal; service to AT&T Park and Angel Island State Park.

The Alameda Ferry Terminal is located at 2990 Main Street. Free parking is available adjacent to the terminal. The Oakland Ferry Terminal is located at 530 Water Street at Jack London Square. Free parking is available at 101 Washington Street.

Tickets are purchased onboard the ferry. One-way fares are:

Adult, \$6.25; Youth (5 to 12 years), \$3.50; Senior (65+ years) or Disabled Persons, \$3.10; Active Military Personnel \$5.00; and Children (under 5 years), free. For complete information, go to www.sanfranciscobayferry.com.
