San Francisco Bay Ferry Launches Online Ticket Reservations for Giants and Cal Games at AT&T Park

SAN FRANCISCO – Giants and Cal football fans can now go online to reserve their ferry tickets and secure a seat on the popular game day ferries for the ride between Alameda and Oakland and AT&T Park in San Francisco.

For the remainder of the Giants baseball season, and for all five 2011 season Cal Bear football games at AT&T Park, riders can use the ferry's new online advance ticketing reservation system to reserve their tickets and receive priority boarding. Available now only for ferry service between Oakland and Alameda and AT&T Park, reservations can be purchased online at the ferry web site until 5:00 PM on the day prior to the game. Ferry Riders will still have the option of purchasing tickets onboard the boat at time of departure.

Departing from Oakland's Jack London Square and Alameda's Main Street Terminal, the 30-45 minute ferry ride delivers riders to the dock at AT&T Park; return ferries depart AT&T Park 30 minutes after the conclusion of the game.

One-way fares for AT&T Park service are: Adults \$7.50; Juniors (5-12 yrs.) \$4.75; Seniors (65+ yrs.)/Disabled Person \$5.25; Active Military Personnel (with ID) \$6.25. Children under five travel free. While riders are strongly encouraged to reserve tickets in advance, tickets will be available for purchase on board at time of departure. Free parking with validation is available at both East Bay docks.

To purchase tickets, riders go to www.eastbayferry.com. Select the game date, number of tickets, and pay online with a VISA, Mastercard, American Express or Discover card. Purchasers will receive a Ticket Confirmation via email which they must print and bring together with a photo ID and purchasing credit card on board at time of departure. No tickets are mailed in advance – will call only.
