## **Bicyclists Ride free for Jack London Square Pedalfest**

San Francisco Bay Ferry announced today that on Saturday, October 22, bicyclists ride free between Oakland, Alameda Main Street, and San Francisco. The San Francisco Bay Ferry free ride offer is in support of Pedalfest, the daylong celebration of all things bicycle being held from 10 AM to 5 PM at Oakland's Jack London Square.

The free ride offer is good all day in any direction. To qualify, bicyclist must board the boat with their bike. Space for bikes is limited and available on a first come first serve basis.

The San Francisco Bay Ferry's Alameda/Oakland/San Francisco line operates year round between San Francisco, Alameda Main Street, and Oakland's Jack London Square, with seasonal service to AT&T Park and Angel Island State Park.

Terminals: In San Francisco, the ferry departs from Pier 41 in the Fisherman's Wharf/Pier 39 area, and from the Ferry Building Gate E. In Oakland, the terminal is at 530 Water Street, Jack London Square. Free parking is available at 201 Washington Street, Oakland. In Alameda the terminal is at 2990 Main Street. Free parking is available adjacent to the dock.

Tickets are available for purchase onboard the ferry. One-way fares are: Adult, \$6.25; Youth (5 to 12 years), \$3.50; Senior (65+ years) or Disabled Persons, \$3.10; Active Military Personnel \$5.00; and Children (under 5 years), free.
